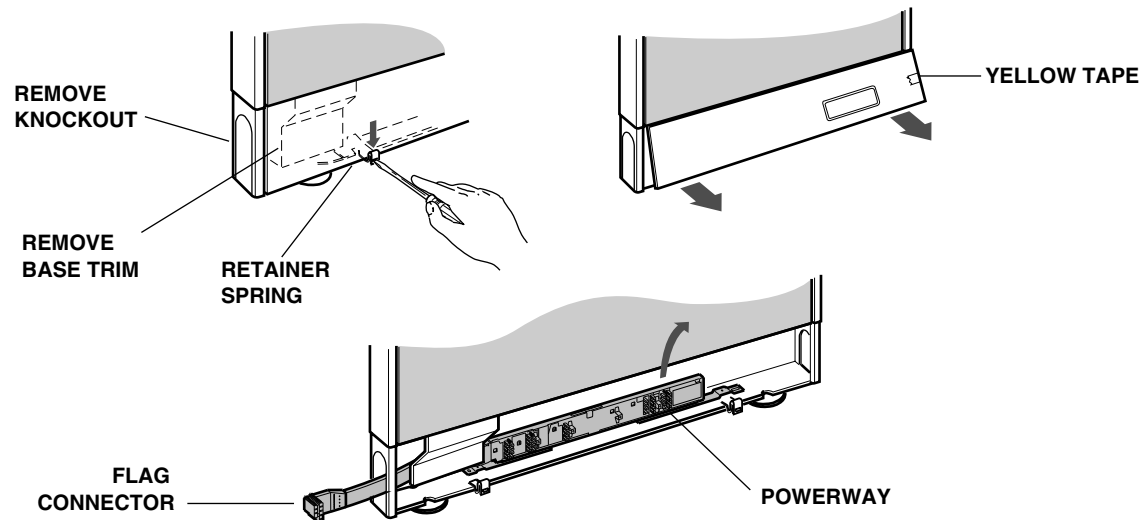
3 Circuit, Shared Neutral Powered by Split Phase Panel



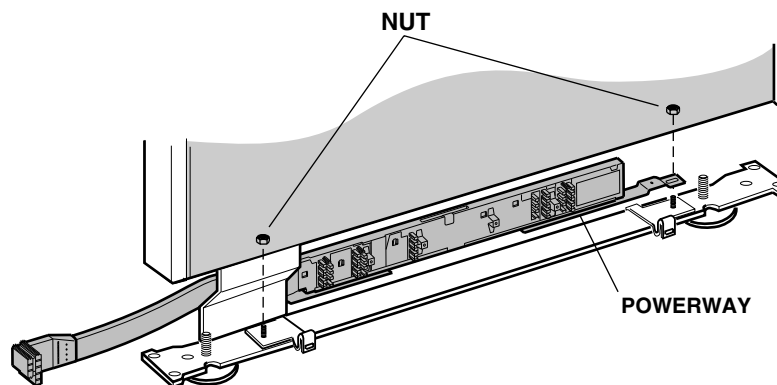
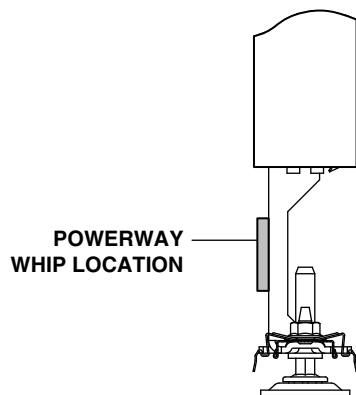
Factory Installed Avenir Powerway

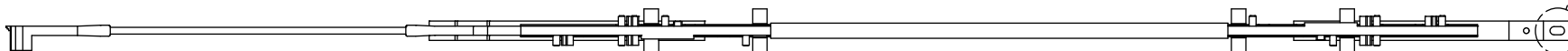
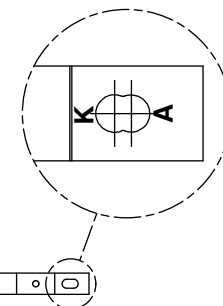

Field Installed Avenir Powerway



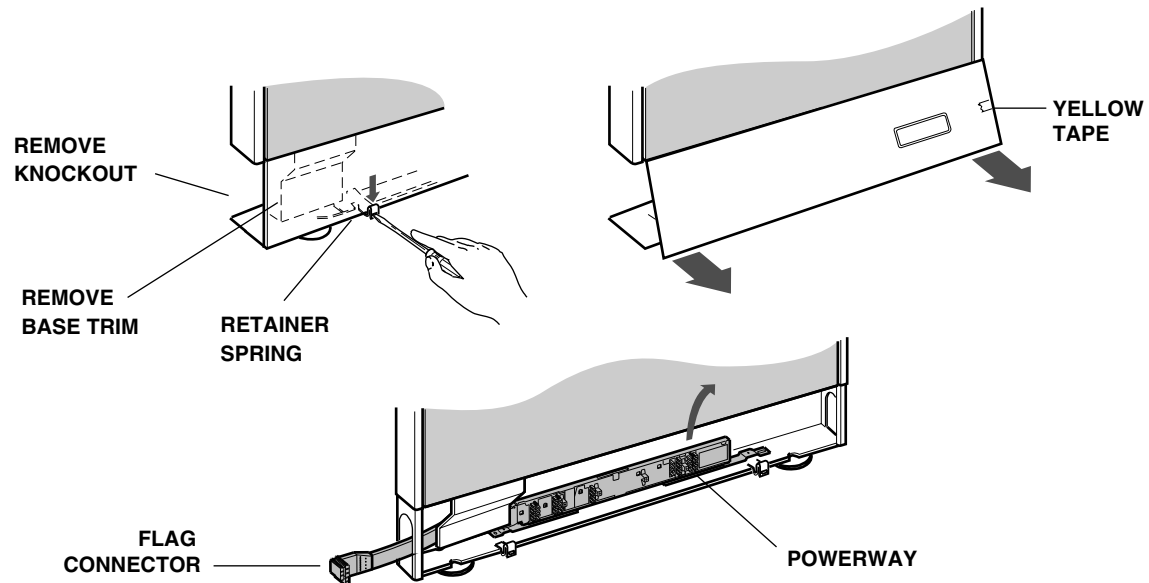

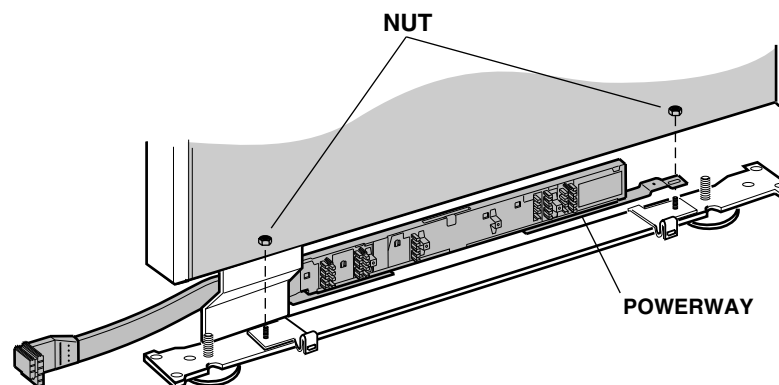
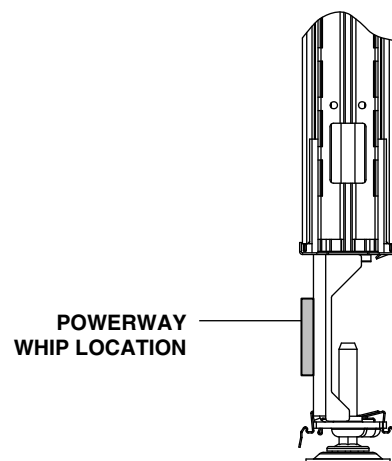
Factory Installed kick Powerway

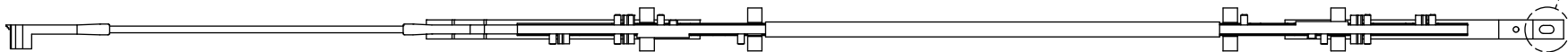
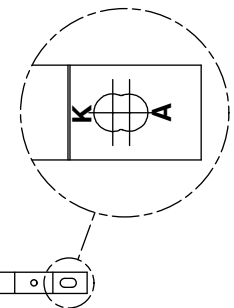

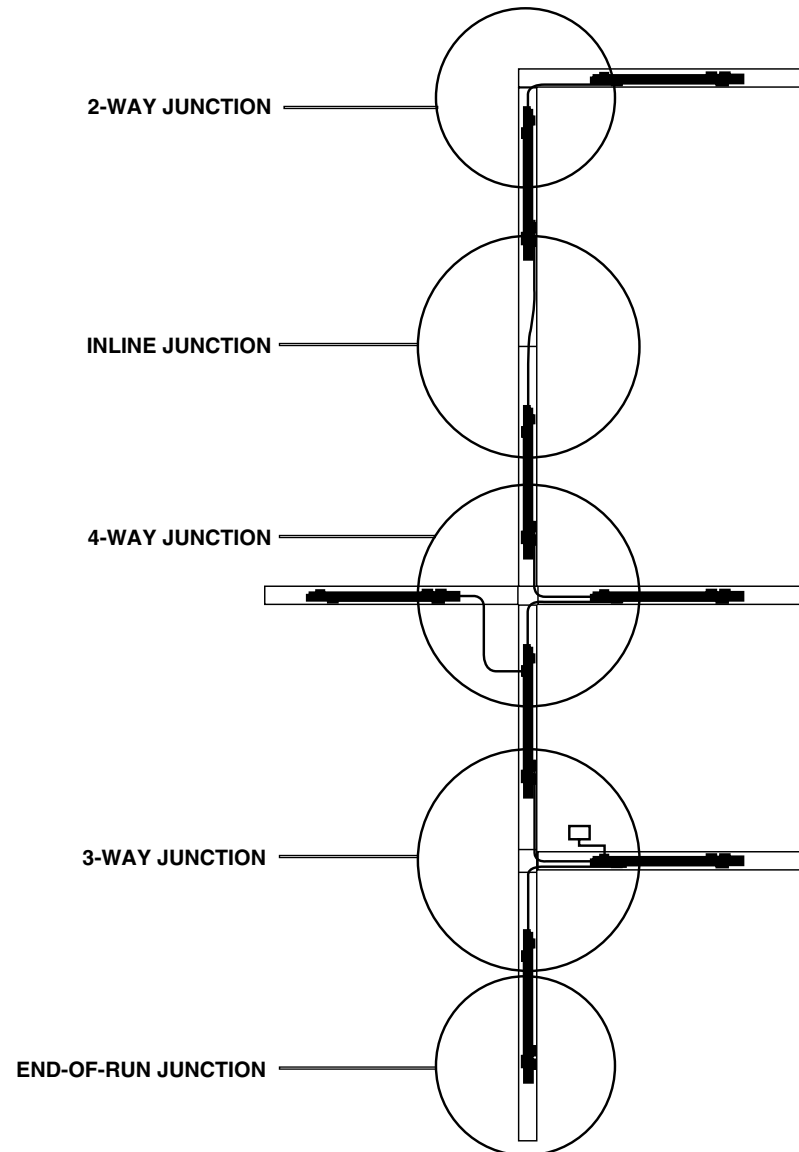


Powerway to Powerway Connections

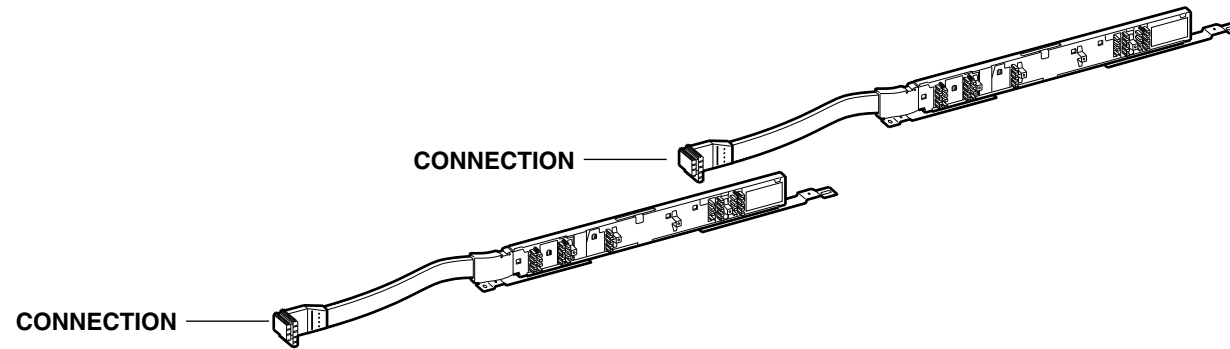
1. Before starting this step, refer to Steelcase Installation Directions 939500720 for Avenir basic panel assembly and 939504744 for kick basic panel assembly.

NOTE: To make powerway to powerway connection, push flag end into the pre-determined J-connector.

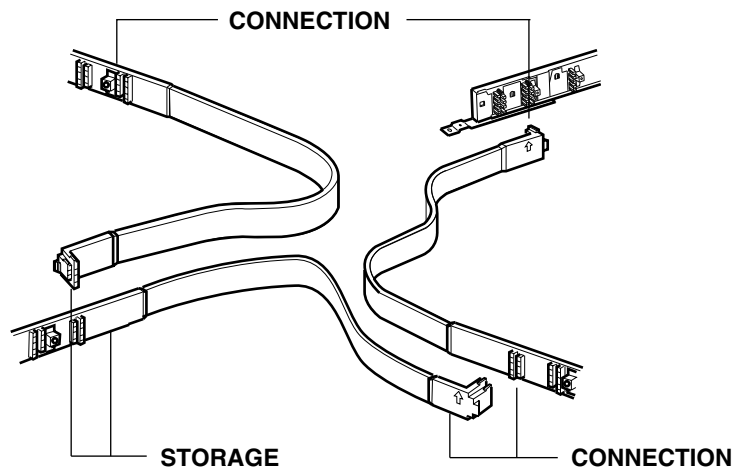
The electrical power (Base Power-in or Power Pole) location must be known prior to installing the powerway.



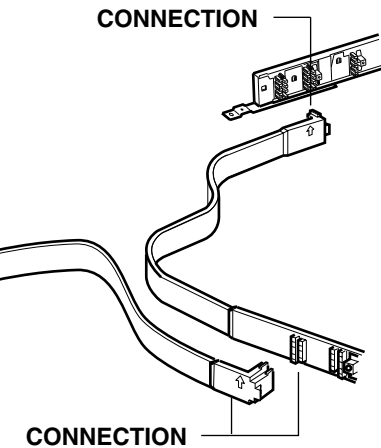
In-line Junction
